THE NUMBER OF THE LAST MONTHS

- Total donations received on 2023, August 28th, from the beginning of the charity: € 2922
- Used for tuition and boarding fees (including logistic fee): € 1966
- including Plant sale: ~ € 80
- including Ugandan handcraft sale: € 30
- Bank fee: ~ € 135
- In bank: ~ € 820 (i.e., enough for the next term)
- 37 donors (17 more than on the previous Newsletter)
- 4 sponsors funding the entire schooling life of 5 children
- One-off donations between € 5 and € 400
- Monthly donations between € 5 and € 20
- 5 new children helped
- 10 children helped, including 3 boys and 7 girls
- Already 21 months of registrations paid
- School fees sent in August 2023 to Uganda: € 680

From May to July, we were in Uganda and we've visited all kids, their schools and their families.

We've used this opportunity to distribute all the donated school supplies (23 kg).

On September and October, they will be sold in benefit of the association in a handcraft market in Scotland. The money will be used to pay next tuition fee of our candidates.

SOLOMON, OUR MANAGER

Without him, nothing would be possible. He is the link between us and the school teachers, the children and their families, and the government officials.

He is constantly looking for new candidates to help and he is the one who pays the tuition fees directly to the schools, each new term.

To thank him for his voluntary help and to help him in return, we have decided to pay the school fees of his youngest child, Sonia. Sonia is 3 years old and will enter baby class next January. She is our 11th candidate and one of our 4 new sponsors, already donates part of her school fees.
